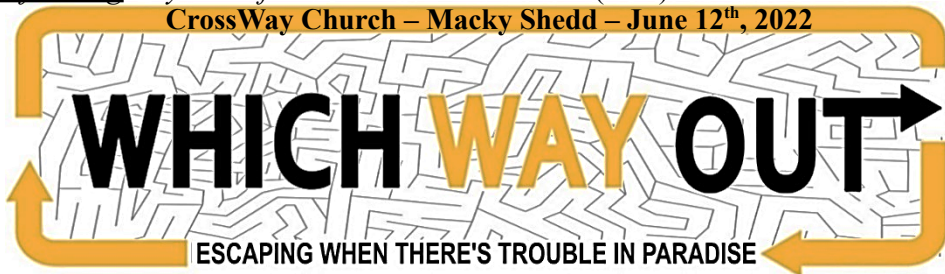
5. RE _____ & RE _____ OF MY _____.
