JESUS, WHAT ARE YOU DOING HERE?

1. JESUS CAME AS A _____.

The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David. And he will reign over Israel forever; his Kingdom will never end! Luke 1:32-33 (NLT)

"So you are a king, then!" said Pilate. Jesus answered, "You say that <u>I am a king</u>. In fact, <u>that's the reason I was born</u>. John 18:37a (NIRV)

2. JESUS CAME TO BRING ME ______.

Jesus traveled throughout the region of Galilee, teaching in the synagogues and announcing the <u>Good News about the Kingdom</u>. And he healed every kind of disease and illness. **Matthew 4:23 (NLT)**

And the <u>Good News about the Kingdom</u> will be preached throughout the whole world, so that all nations will hear it; and then the end will come. **Matthew 24:14 (NLT)**

But now the people believed Philip's message of <u>Good News concerning the</u> <u>Kingdom of God</u> and the name of Jesus Christ. <u>As a result</u>, many men and women were baptized. **Acts 8:12 (NLT)**

4. JESUS CAME TO CALL ME TO

...suppose a king is about to go to war against another king. Won't he first sit down and consider whether he is able with ten thousand men to oppose the one coming against him with twenty thousand? ³² If he is not able, he will send a delegation while the other is still a long way off and will <u>ask for terms of peace</u>. ³³ In the same way, those of you who do not give up <u>everything</u> you have cannot be my disciples. Luke 14:31-33 (NIV)

"<u>No one can serve two masters</u>; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon [money, possessions, fame, status, or whatever is valued more than the Lord]. Matthew 6:24 (AMP)

But when the man heard this he became very sad, for he was very rich.²⁴ When Jesus saw this, he said, "<u>How hard it is for the rich to enter the</u> <u>Kingdom of God</u>! Luke 18:23-24 (NLT)

5. JESUS IS COMING TO _____

Think of David's words about Him not being abandoned to the place of the dead nor being left to decay in the grave. ³² He was talking about Jesus, the One God has raised, whom all of us have seen with our own eyes and announce to you today... ³⁶ Everyone in Israel should now realize with certainty what God has done: God has made Jesus both Lord and Anointed King—this same Jesus whom you crucified. Acts 2:31b-32, 36 (VOICE)
