Be persistent and devoted to prayer, being alert and focused in your prayer life with an attitude of thanksgiving. Colossians 4:2 (AMP)

1. Because It Keeps My \_\_\_\_\_ On God.

My eyes look to the LORD continuously, because he's the one who releases my feet from the trap. Psalm 25:15 (ISV)

## 2. It Builds My \_\_\_\_\_ With God.

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—<sup>2</sup> for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.<sup>3</sup> This is good, and pleases God our Savior... 1 Timothy 2:1-3 (NIV)

#### 3. Having To \_\_\_\_\_ Teaches Me About \_\_\_\_\_.

... I will test with fire, purifying them like silver, testing them like gold. Then they will call on me, and I will answer them. I will say, 'You are my people,' and they will say, 'The Lord is our God.'" Zechariah 13:9b (NCV)
