#### 1. A \_\_\_\_\_ ON & \_\_\_\_\_ OF GOD'S \_\_\_\_\_.

After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: “Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you.”<sup>2</sup> For you granted him authority over all people that he might give eternal life to all those you have given him.<sup>3</sup> Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.<sup>4</sup> I have brought you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do.<sup>5</sup> And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began.” **John 17:1-5 (NIV)**

“Pray then like this: “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.” **Matthew 6:9 (ESV)**

Jesus replied, “If I glorify myself, my glory means nothing. My Father, whom you claim as your God, is the one who glorifies me.” **John 8:54 (NIV)**

“Yours, O Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty, for all that is in the heavens and in the earth is yours. Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and you are exalted as head above all.” **1 Chronicles 29:11 (ESV)**

They knew with certainty that I came from you, and they believed that you sent me.” **John 17:4, 6-8 (NIV)**
