And the messenger who went to summon Micaiah said to him, “Behold, the words of the prophets with one accord are favorable to the king. Let your word be like the word of one of them, and speak favorably.”¹⁴ But Micaiah said, “As the Lord lives, what the Lord says to me, that I will speak.” **1 Kings 22:13-14 (ESV)**

Also, men from your own group will begin to teach things that are wrong. They will lead some of the Lord’s followers away from the truth to follow them. **Acts 20:30 (ERV)**

THE PROPHETS’ PROPHECIES ON FALSE PROPHECIES:

Thus says the Lord of hosts: “Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you, filling you with vain hopes. They speak visions of their own minds, not from the mouth of the Lord.”¹⁷ They say continually to those who despise the word of the Lord, ‘It shall be well with you’; and to everyone who stubbornly follows his own heart, they say, ‘No disaster shall come upon you.’” **Jeremiah 23:16-17 (ESV)**

Application: I’ll Reject Teachings That _____ Or _____ Sin.

Then the prophet Hananiah took the yoke off the neck of the prophet Jeremiah and broke it,¹¹ and he said before all the people, “This is what the Lord says: ‘In the same way I will break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon off the neck of all the nations within two years...’”¹⁵ Then the prophet Jeremiah said to Hananiah the prophet, “Listen, Hananiah! The Lord has not sent you, yet you have persuaded this nation to trust in lies.”¹⁶ Therefore this is what the Lord says: ‘I am about to remove you from the face of the earth. This very year you are going to die, because you have preached rebellion against the Lord.’”¹⁷ In the seventh month of that same year, Hananiah the prophet died. **Jeremiah 28:10-11a, 15-17 (NIV)**

Application: I Will Test _____ With God’s Word.

The word of the Lord came to me:² “Son of man, prophesy against the prophets of Israel, who are prophesying, and say to those who prophesy from their own hearts: ‘Hear the word of the Lord!’”¹⁰ Precisely because they have misled my people, saying, ‘Peace,’ when there is no peace, and because, when the people build a wall, these prophets smear it with whitewash,¹¹ say to those who smear it with whitewash that it shall fall! There will be a deluge of rain, and you, O great hailstones, will fall, and a stormy wind break out.¹² And when the wall falls, will it not be said to you, ‘Where is the coating with which you smeared it?’ **Ezekiel 13:1-2, 10-12 (NIV)**

THE APOSTLES’ DOCTRINE (TEACHING), ON FALSE DOCTRINE:

• THE APOSTLE PETER’S DOCTRINE ON FALSE DOCTRINE:

False prophets appeared in the past among the people, and in the same way false teachers will appear among you. They will bring in destructive, untrue doctrines, and will deny the Master who redeemed them, and so they will bring upon themselves sudden destruction.² Even so, many will follow their immoral ways; and because of what they do, others will speak evil of the Way of truth.³ In their greed these false teachers will make a profit out of telling you made-up stories. For a long time now their Judge has been ready, and their Destroyer has been wide awake! **2 Peter 2:1-3 (GNT)**

Applicaton: I Will Learn To _____ & _____ The Threat.

Some things in his (Paul’s) letters are hard to understand. Ignorant people and people who aren’t sure of what they believe distort what Paul says in his letters the same way they distort the rest of the Scriptures. These people will be destroyed.¹⁷ Dear friends, you already know these things. So be on your guard not to be carried away by the deception of people who have no principles. Then you won’t fall from your firm position. **2 Peter 3:16-17 (GW)**

• THE APOSTLE PAUL’S DOCTRINE ON FALSE DOCTRINE:

Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both yourself and your hearers. **1 Timothy 4:16 (NIV)**

Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favorable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching.³ For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching. They will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear. **2 Timothy 4:2-3 (NLT)**

Liars and frauds may go around and say, “We will preach to you about wine and liquor.” They would be just the type of preacher you want. **Micah 2:11 (GW)**

• THE APOSTLE JOHN’S DOCTRINE ON FALSE DOCTRINE:

“Very truly I tell you Pharisees, anyone who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in by some other way, is a thief and a robber.”² The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep.³ The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.⁴ When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice.⁵ But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a stranger’s voice.” **John 10:1-5 (NIV)**
