Be <u>shepherds</u> of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood. **Acts 20:17-18a, 28 (NIV)**

The word of the Lord came to me: <sup>2</sup> "Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel; prophesy and say to them: 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: Woe to you shepherds of Israel who only take care of yourselves! Should not shepherds take care of the flock? <sup>3</sup> You eat the curds, clothe yourselves with the wool and slaughter the choice animals, but you do not take care of the flock. <sup>4</sup> You have not strengthened the weak or healed the sick or bound up the injured. You have not brought back the strays or searched for the lost. You have ruled them harshly and brutally. <sup>5</sup> So they were scattered because there was no shepherd, and when they were scattered they became food for all the wild animals. <sup>6</sup> My sheep wandered over all the mountains and on every high hill. They were scattered over the whole earth, and no one searched or looked for them... <sup>10</sup> This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I am against the shepherds and will hold them accountable for my flock. I will remove them from tending the flock so that the shepherds can no longer feed themselves. I will rescue my flock from their mouths, and it will no longer be food for them. Here is a trustworthy saying: Whoever aspires to be an overseer desires a noble task. <sup>2</sup> Now the overseer is to be above reproach, faithful to his wife, temperate, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, <sup>3</sup> not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. <sup>4</sup> He must manage his own family well and see that his children obey him, and he must do so in a manner worthy of full respect. <sup>5</sup> (If anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he take care of God's church?) <sup>6</sup> He must not be a recent convert, or he may become conceited and fall under the same judgment as the devil. <sup>7</sup> He must also have a good reputation with outsiders, so that he will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap. 1 Timothy 3:1-7 (NIV)

2. BUILD A THAT WITHSTANDS  Now the overseer is to be above reproach 1 Timothy 3:2a (NIV)
Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day he visits us. 1 Peter 2:12 (NIV)
As soon as the chief priests and their officials saw him, they shouted, "Crucify! Crucify!" But Pilate answered, "You take him and crucify him. As for me, I find no basis for a charge against him." <b>John 19:6 (NIV)</b>
3. BE TO MY faithful to his wife 1 Timothy 3:2b (NIV) Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her 26 to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, 27 and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. Ephesians 5:25-27 (NIV)
I am jealous for you with a godly jealousy. I promised you to <u>one husband</u> , to Christ, so that I might present you as a pure virgin to him. <b>2 Corinthians 11:2 (NIV)</b>
4. KEEP MY IN CHECK DURING
Now the overseer is to betemperate" 1 Timothy 3:2c (NIV)
Jesus commanded Peter, "Put your sword away! John 18:11a (NIV)
5. ALLOW TO MY LIFE.
Now the overseer is to be self-controlled 1 Timothy 3:2d (NIV)
But the fruit of the Spirit is self-control Galatians 5:22, 23a (NIV)
6. SET AN OTHERS &
Now the overseer is to berespectable 1 Timothy 3:2e (NIV)
People were overwhelmed with amazement. "He has done everything well," they said. Mark 7:37 (NIV)
7 PEOPLE THAT ARE
Now the overseer is to behospitable 1 Timothy 3:2f (NIV)
When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today." <sup>6</sup> So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly. <sup>7</sup> All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner." <b>Luke 19:5-7 (NIV)</b>
8. BE TO TEACH
Now the overseer is to beable to teach 1 Timothy 3:2g (NIV)
In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food! <b>Hebrews 5:11-12 (NIV)</b>
