By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter.²⁵ He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin.²⁶ He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.²⁷ By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he persevered because he saw him who is invisible.²⁸ By faith he kept the Passover and the application of blood, so that the destroyer of the firstborn would not touch the firstborn of Israel.²⁹ By faith the people passed through the Red Sea as on dry land; but when the Egyptians tried to do so, they were drowned. **Hebrews 11:24-29 (NIV)**

1. I _____ Egypt's _____ To Define Me.

By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. **Hebrews 11:24 (NIV)**

Our citizenship is in heaven, and we eagerly wait for a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ. **Philippians 3:20 (CSB)**

Do you think I am trying to make people accept me? No, God is the One I am trying to please. Am I trying to please people? If I still wanted to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ. **Galatians 1:10 (NCV)**

2. I _____ Suffering Over _____.

He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. **Hebrews 11:25 (NIV)**

For it is commendable if someone bears up under the pain of unjust suffering because they are conscious of God.²⁰ But how is it to your credit if you receive a beating for doing wrong and endure it? But if you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God. **1 Peter 2:19-20 (NIV)**

3. I _____ My Past _____ With Faith.

When Pharaoh heard what Moses had done, he sought to kill Moses. Moses, however, fled from Pharaoh's presence and went to live in the land of Midian. **Exodus 2:15 (NIV)**

No matter how many times you trip them up, God-loyal people don't stay down long; Soon they're up on their feet, while the wicked end up flat on their faces. **Proverbs 24:16 (MSG)**

He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Most gladly therefore I will rather glory in my weaknesses, that the power of Christ may rest on me. **2 Corinthians 12:9 (WEB)**

4. I _____ All Of My _____.

Moses was educated in all the wisdom of the Egyptians and was powerful in speech and action. **Hebrews 11:9-10 (NIV)**

Moses said to the Lord, "Pardon your servant, Lord. I have never been eloquent, neither in the past nor since you have spoken to your servant. I am slow of speech and tongue."

¹¹ The Lord said to him, "Who gave human beings their mouths? Who makes them deaf or mute? Who gives them sight or makes them blind? Is it not I, the Lord?" ¹² Now go; I will help you speak and will teach you what to say." **Exodus 4:10-12 (NIV)**

5. I _____ For People.

So Moses went back to the Lord and said, "Oh, what a great sin these people have committed! They have made themselves gods of gold.³² But now, please forgive their sin—but if not, then blot me out of the book you have written." **Exodus 32:31-32 (NIV)**

With Christ as my witness, I speak with utter truthfulness. My conscience and the Holy Spirit confirm it.² My heart is filled with bitter sorrow and unending grief³ for my people, my Jewish brothers and sisters. I would be willing to be forever cursed—cut off from Christ!—if that would save them. **Romans 9:1-3 (NLT)**

6. I _____ My _____ Instead Of _____ My Problems.

By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he persevered because he saw him who is invisible. **Hebrews 11:27 (NIV)**

I keep my eyes always on the Lord. With him at my right hand, I will not be shaken. **Psalms 16:8 (NIV)**

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." **Joshua 1:9 (NIV)**

7. I _____ God's _____ For My Salvation.

By faith he kept the Passover and the application of blood, so that the destroyer of the firstborn would not touch the firstborn of Israel. **Hebrews 11:28 (NIV)**

"... let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah."

³⁷ When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?"³⁸ Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. **Acts 2:36-38 (NIV)**

8. I Allow God To _____ My _____.

By faith the people passed through the Red Sea as on dry land; but when the Egyptians tried to do so, they were drowned. **Hebrews 11:29 (NIV)**

For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea.² They were all baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. **1 Corinthians 10:1-2 (NIV)**

We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life...¹⁷ But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you have come to obey from your heart the pattern of teaching that has now claimed your allegiance.¹⁸ You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness. **Romans 6:4, 17-18 (NIV)**
